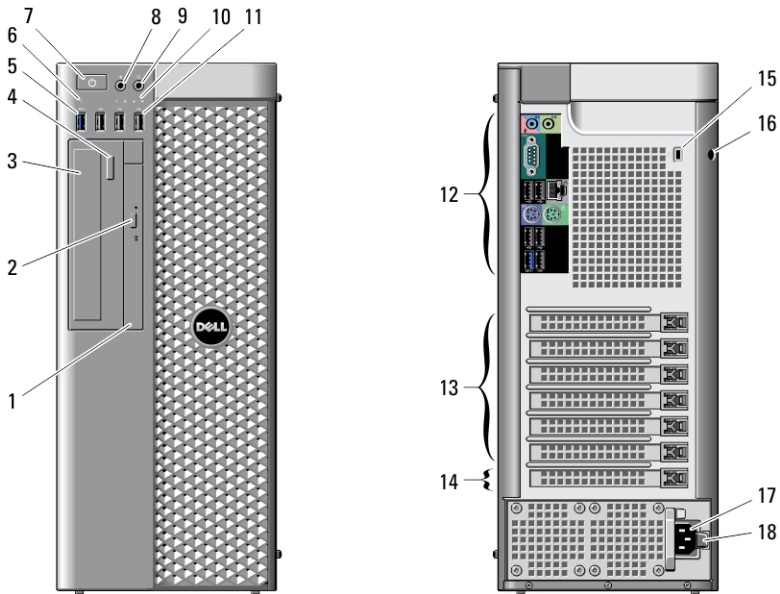


Figure 1. Front View and Back View

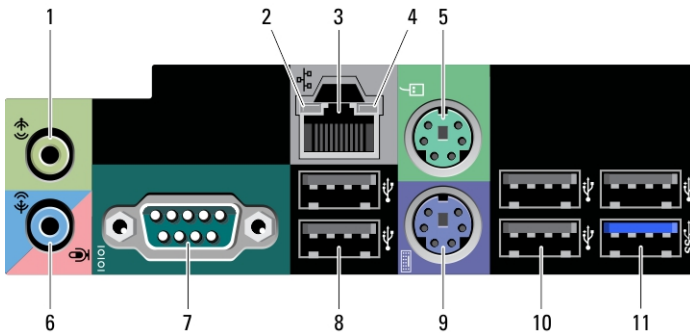

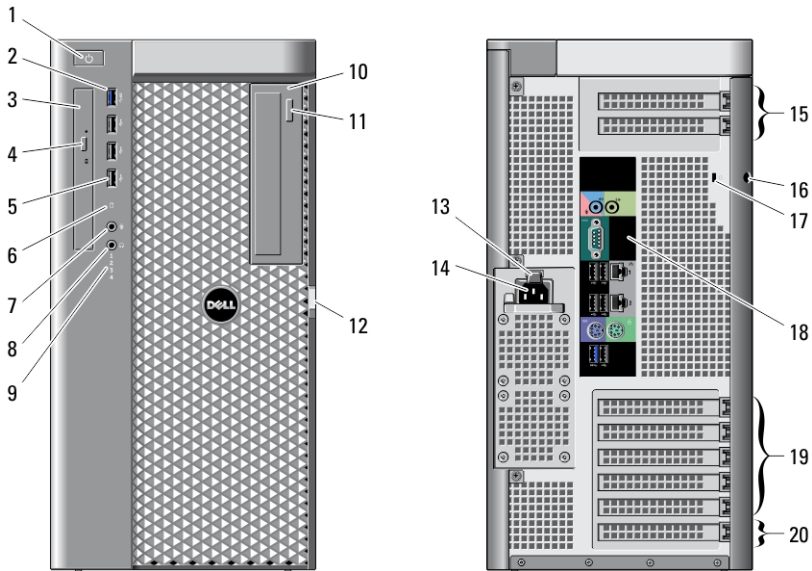

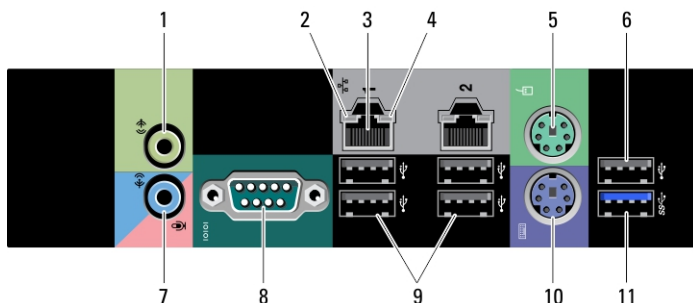


**Figure 3. Front View and Back View**

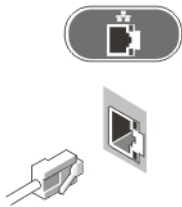

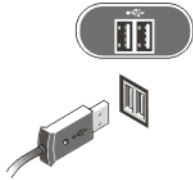

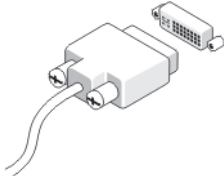
**Figure 5. Network Connection**
