


Figure 1. Front And Back View Of Mini-Tower






Figure 2. Front And Back View Of Desktop




Figure 3. Back Panel View of Mini-Tower And Desktop




Figure 4. Front And Back View Of Small Form Factor




Figure 5. Back Panel View of Small Form Factor




Figure 7. VGA Connector
