


Figure 1. Front View




Figure 2. Back View




Figure 3. Base View




Figure 4. Front View




Figure 5. Back View




Figure 6. Base View




Figure 8. Network Connector




Figure 9. USB Connector




Figure 10. IEEE 1394 Connector on M4700
