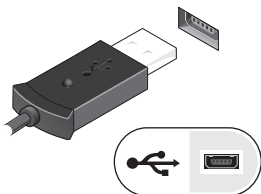
- 1 Connect the AC adapter to the AC adapter connector on the portable computer and to the electrical outlet.



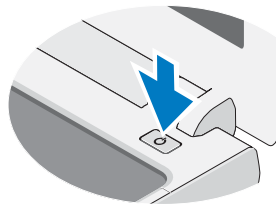
- 2 Connect the network cable (optional).
