Dell SupportAssist Agent

Dell SupportAssist automates support from Dell by proactively identifying hardware and software issues on Dell laptops, desktops, and tablets. When an issue is detected, SupportAssist notifies you about the issue and automatically creates a support request with Dell. The data required for troubleshooting the issue is automatically collected from the device and sent securely to Dell Technical Support. This information allows Dell to provide you with an enhanced, personalized, and efficient support experience.

Dell SupportAssist has two primary capabilities:

- The SupportAssist application — For automated periodic system diagnostic scan.
- The SupportAssist Agent — Monitor scanned issues and logs. Automates the notification to Dell Technical support for parts dispatch or technical support requests.

SupportAssist Agent automates support from Dell for the following devices:

 - Dell Alienware
 - Dell OptiPlex
 - Dell Precision
- Tablet devices
 - Dell Venue Pro 11

Limitations

- SupportAssist Agent does not support zoom in/zoom out feature on Tablet devices.
- SupportAssist Agent does not run diagnostic tests for the the microphone, keyboard, and graphics cards because diagnostic tests for these components require user intervention.

Important Notes

The command for deploying SupportAssist on multiple devices is represented incorrectly in the non-English versions of the SupportAssist Agent Deployment Guide. The correct command for deploying SupportAssist on multiple devices is as follows:

```
Setup.exe -answerfilepath -s -v"/qn <common network location of the SupportAssist answer file>"
```

Installation Prerequisites

The following are the minimum requirements for installing and using SupportAssist Agent:

- Operating system
 - Laptops and desktops:
 - Microsoft Windows XP (32-bit SP3)
 - Microsoft Windows Vista (32-bit and 64-bit)
 - Microsoft Windows 7 (32-bit and 64-bit)
 - Microsoft Windows 8 (32-bit and 64-bit)
 - Microsoft Windows 8.1 (32-bit and 64-bit)
 - Tablet devices:
 - Microsoft Windows 8.1
- Web browser: Internet Explorer 8 or later
- Software: Microsoft .NET Framework 3.5.1 or later
- Internet connection
- Hardware
 - Memory (RAM): 2GB
 - Hard drive: 512MB

NOTE: SupportAssist Agent can monitor one or more devices. To monitor a single device, you must install SupportAssist Agent on the device. To monitor multiple devices using SupportAssist Agent, install SupportAssist Agent on the devices you want to monitor and then deploy the answer file.

Installation Instructions

SupportAssist Agent is downloaded and installed automatically in the background after you install or update SupportAssist.

Uninstallation

1. Press the <Windows logo key>. The Start menu or the Start screen is displayed.
2. Click Control Panel.
 - On Microsoft Windows 8 operating system:
 - a. Click Uninstall a program in Programs.
 - b. Click Uninstall a program in Programs and Features.
 - On Microsoft Windows 7 operating system:
 - a. Click Control Panel.
 - b. Click Programs.
 - c. Click Add or Remove Programs.
 - d. Click Uninstall a program.
 - On Microsoft Windows Vista operating system:
 - a. Click Control Panel.
 - b. Click Programs and Features.
 - c. Click Add or Remove Programs.
 - On Microsoft Windows XP operating system:
 - a. Click Control Panel.
 - b. Click Add or Remove Programs.
3. Right-click on SupportAssist, and click Uninstall.
4. If you are prompted to confirm the uninstallation, click Yes. SupportAssist is uninstalled.
5. Right-click on Dell SupportAssist Agent, and click Uninstall.
6. If you are prompted to confirm the uninstallation, click Yes. Dell SupportAssist Agent is uninstalled.
