Known Issues

Issue (490350):

Manual execution of recovery, updates the NIC Group health incorrectly. When a recovery is initiated, on older states of NIC Group Unit Monitors, the current state of the NIC Group health changes to the older state.

Resolution

Manually execute the recovery on the latest state-change.

Versions Affected

Issue (049913):

Feature Management dashboard is not available, if the Management Pack Suite is installed on a clustered RMS node.

Resolution

Refer to the Installation Guide "Feature Management Dashboard Does Not Populate" section under Troubleshooting.

Issue (EQLMP-4):

In the Feature Management dashboard, "Configure License Server" task is shown for EqualLogic monitoring feature, even though no license-configuration or licenses are required for monitoring EqualLogic devices.

Resolution

Issue (EQLMP-5):

For PS6100 Controller Group, health is shown incorrectly as OK when controller battery is removed.

Installation

To install the Dell EqualLogic Management Pack Suite, run the installer executable. For detailed installation, prerequisites, configuration, upgrade and uninstallation instructions, refer the Installation Guide.

To install Dell EqualLogic Management Pack version 6.0.1, follow the below steps:

Prerequisite:

- Ensure that you have installed Dell EqualLogic Storage Management Pack Suite Version 6.0 for Microsoft System Center Operations Manager.
 - 1. Download the self-extracting executable;
 - Dell_EqualLogic_Storage_Management_Pack_Suite_v6.0.1_Axx.exe from the Dell support site, dell.com/support.
 - 2. Extract the downloaded file in a local drive.
 - 3. Log in to the Operations Manager console.
 - 4. From the navigation pane, select **Administration**.
 - 5. Under Administration, select Management Packs > Installed Management Packs.
 - 6. Import the Dell EqualLogic Management Pack. To import the Management Pack, do one of the following:
 - a) On the left pane, right-click Installed Management Packs, and select Import Management Packs.

- b) In the **Task pane**, select **Import Management Packs**. The **Import Management Packs** wizard is displayed.
- 7. Click **Add** > **Add from disk** from the drop-down menu. The **Select Management Packs to import** wizard is displayed.
- 8. Go to the local drive where you have downloaded the .mp file.
- 9. Select the downloaded file, and then click **Open**.
- 10. Select file, Dell.OperationsLibrary.EqualLogic.mp and click Install and then Close.

After importing the Management Pack, you can view the updated version of the Management Pack as 6.0.0.3 on the Installed Management Packs wizard.
