Known Issues and Limitations

• Description: Mismatch in the BIOS attributes in Server Administrator 8.2 and F2 BIOS.

On Dell PowerEdge R905 running the Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7.2 operating system, the BIOS **Setup** page in Server Administrator 8.2 displays an attribute called **DUAL NIC**. This **DUAL NIC** attribute is displayed in the operating system report, but not displayed in the **F2** BIOS screen.

Resolution: This is a known issue and does not cause any functionality limitation. The fix for this issue can be expected in the next available version of Dell OpenManage Server Administrator.

 Description: NVMe PCIe SSDs are not detected on the latest version of Dell OpenManage Storage Services.



NOTE: NVMe PCIe SSDs are not supported on systems running the Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7.2 operating system. The fix for this issue can be expected in the next available version of Dell OpenManage Storage Services.
