Release summary

Dell Command | Update is installed as a stand-alone application on a business client supported platform to provide updates for system software released by Dell. This application is installed locally on the target systems and simplifies the BIOS, firmware, driver, and application update experience on Dell client hardware. This application can also be used to install drivers after the operating system and network drivers are installed based on the system identity.

Dell Command | Update is primarily targeted at customers who want to manage systems on their own. The tool is designed to allow users to specify their update preferences and apply updates based on the criticality. Alternatively, user can use the scheduling option to keep their system up-to-date with the systems software released by Dell.

What's new in Dell Command | Update Version 3.1.1

Dell Command | Update provides the following features and enhancements in this release:

- Updated Json.NET library to version 12.0.3.
- Support for proxy enhancements in an enterprise environment.
- Support for Declarative Componentized Hardware (DCH) drivers for the Advanced Driver Restore feature on Windows 10 operating systems.
- Addressed arbitrary file overwrite issues.
- Fixed offline catalog functionality issues when the system is not connected to the internet.
- Fixed the issue where **The system has been updated** notification is displayed, when no updates are applied.
- A system reboot is not initiated during self-update of Dell Command | Update for Windows 10.

Known issues

The System Password under Settings -> BIOS does not support the double quote (") character.

The Custom Proxy settings (Settings -> General -> Internet Proxy) is required while participating in the Dell Command | Update Improvement Program, the system is using a web proxy which requires authentication.

Dell Command | Update displays a message "This system is up-to-date" if a custom catalog (Settings -> General -> Update Source Location) is not found or has errors.

When Dell Command | Update GUI is launched in administrative mode, a warning message is displayed while applying the updates.
