# Release summary

The Dell EMC OpenManage Operations Connector for Micro Focus Operations Bridge Manager (OBM) enables the integration of OpenManage Essentials or OpenManage Enterprise (OME) with Micro Focus OBM. The Operations Connector for OME helps system and IT administrators to get a comprehensive view of the Dell EMC devices in a data center by collecting the systems management data about the Events and Topology from OME, and transferring it to Micro Focus OBM. It also enables you to launch OME directly from the Micro Focus OBM environment to troubleshoot, configure, and manage activities for the Dell EMC devices.

## Limitations

When compared to OpenManage Essentials/OpenManage Enterprise, additional alerts may appear in the Microfocus Operations Bridge Manager console.

**Description:** Device in OME is deleted post events received for those device. Those events will disappear from the OME console, however same events still shown in Microfocus OBM console

**Resolution:** Setting the filter to Dell EMC Device view in **Event Perspective** -> **Event browser** of the Microfocus Operations Bridge Manager console will solve the issue.

Unable to manage policies through operations connector user interface

**Description:** Adobe Flash Player is End Of Life.

**Resolution:** To manage policies use operations connector command line tools.

- Synchronization of Event information from OpenManage Enterprise to Micro Focus Operations Bridge Manager.
- Custom view support for viewing Dell EMC devices in Micro Focus Operations Bridge Manager console.
- Web URL console launch for OpenManage Enterprise from node and alert to perform further troubleshooting, configuration, and management activities.
- Notifying the user about the number of nodes that are collected by Dell EMC OpenManage Operations Connector for Micro Focus OBM.
